As we celebrate a new year, the Elk Rapids Harbor Days Association has hit the ground running in planning for our 69th festival! Our goal is to honor history as well as grow for the future, and we *invite you* to be a part of the 2024 celebration!

#### History

Elk Rapids Harbor Days began in 1955 to help the Rotary Club raise funds to build the town harbor. The governor dedicated the harbor in 1961 and commended the people of Elk Rapids for undertaking and completing the harbor without any State help. Since then, the festival became an opportunity to celebrate our vibrant area with locals and tourists. The Chamber of Commerce managed the festival until 2011, when the Elk Rapids Harbor Days Association became a separate, non-profit entity, whose only purpose is to host and manage the festival.

#### Community Benefit

The festival also serves as a base for significant annual fundraisers for some of our local non-profit organizations, who provide good works for the community all year long. These groups receive 100% of the proceeds from their events, including:

Our 2024 goal is to host and diversify events and raise awareness with a wider community reach.

### Financial Impact

Most of the funding for the festival is donation-based, which allows most of our events to be offered free of charge. Fixed administrative costs and insurance are 10% of the budget, and overall festival costs increased 30% from 2022 to 2023. Harbor Days draws approximately 10,000 visitors to the area. Conservative direct and indirect economic impact to local businesses and community residents exceeds \$750,000.
